Registration 2017-2018

Registration will take place on February 26th and 27th (Monday & Tuesday) from 2:30-5:00pm in the main building near the office. You will need to come in and fill out all forms in person on one of the dates listed above. You will then receive your registration packet containing the 2018-2019 school calendar, a new emergency card to fill out and return, and a new financial agreement reflecting the 2018-2019 rate. The rate change will take effect June 1st 2018. There is a non-refundable \$40 registration fee and \$100 deposit due at the time of registration payable by check or cash.

Communication

Please speak directly with your child's teacher regarding any changes, questions or concerns. If your child's teacher is not available, please leave them a short note. Absences, vacations, and all other questions regarding our services are to be directed to our Director, Jessica. Please call or leave a note.

Parking

When parking in front of the school or in the surrounding area, please use caution. Our street is very busy during our drop off and pick up times. Please be aware of pedestrians when pulling in and out of parking areas. The lane located across the street is a private road. Please do not park in it.

Flu virus

The US mainland continues to see extremely high numbers of the flu virus. Children are among the group at highest risk for flu-related complications. Please report any cases immediately to the office so that we can issue a Health Alert to all families. Many physicians are no longer swabbing and testing for the virus due to the widespread cases seen. Please report any medically diagnosed cases whether your child was swabbed or not. Please be sure to seek medical care if you or your child experiences any flu like symptoms. In the event your child has the flu they need to remain out of school for 7 days after the onset of the illness. For more information on the flu go to health.hawaii.gov .
