Registration 2025-2026

Registration Forms and Financial Agreements will be sent out on the Remind App this month. You will need to fill them out and return them to the office along with your non-refundable annual registration fee of \$140 payable by cash or check. You will receive a copy of the 2025-2026 school calendar once they are ready. We are awaiting any revisions from DOE to their calendar as we try to mimic our breaks. Registration will close March 14th and spaces will open to wait listed families. Please have all forms in by March 14th.

Kindergarten

Many of our Montessori 3-6 students will be kindergarten eligible for the 2025-2026 school year (must be 5 years old by July 31st). Please be sure to register with your designated school ASAP. Registration has already begun and the window for Geographical Exemptions ends March 1st.

Parking

When parking in front of the school or in the surrounding area, please use caution. Our street is very busy during our drop off and pick-up times. Please be aware of pedestrians when pulling in and out of parking areas. Please do not block the driveway to the staff parking. Lastly, the lane located across the street is a private road. Please do not park in it.
