Breakfast

Breakfast is not included with our program. The children may bring breakfast with them each morning. In the Infant and Toddler classes, breakfast may be brought in and served before 8:00am. In the Toddler Too and Montessori 3-6 classes, breakfast must be completed by 7:30am. If you arrive with breakfast right before or after these times, you will be instructed to stay with your child until they are finished.

Children's Personal Belongings

All items brought to school must be clearly labeled. Our lost and found increases daily, especially the slipper and shoe baskets. Please check these areas weekly. Please do not ask the staff to search for missing items. Each class has an area where the children are instructed to place these items when they are not in use. Also, foot wear is not required except on excursion days. We encourage the children to have independence and along with that comes responsibility for their belongings.

Child's Last Day

As a reminder if your child will be exiting the school, a notice of withdrawal form needs to be completed and returned to the office 30 days prior to your child's last day. You can pick this form up from the office.
