COVID Cohort Testing Preregistration

Dr. Brit Reis of Reis Pediatrics has reached out to us and other local preschools to offer us the ability to preregister for a cohort drive thru COVID testing at Castle Medical Center. She has urged schools to take this step to be **prepared** for a positive case within our school whether it is a student, parent, or staff member. This allows us to be prepared in case of exposure and would only be take place in the event of exposure. We would be given a designated appointment slot for our school so all students, family members, and staff could get tested. Preregistration forms need to be turned into **the school** at drop off or pick up. Dr. Reis will pick them up from us once they are completed. You do not need to be a patient of Dr. Reis to utilize this program.
